AWARDS - Ribbons and gift cards to students; \$300 to graduating senior. Ribbons to clubwomen. Clubwomen winners at the national level receive GFWC monetary awards.

A Note About Photo Mounting - Rigid mount board may be found at places such as Michael's and Aaron Brothers, usually a lightweight foam-type board which must be cut to fit (average cost \$16). Acid-free spray adhesive is also available at these stores (average cost \$8.50).

An acceptable alternative is printing directly onto lightweight board/cardstock. My local UPS store does this for about \$2.00, plus there is a fold-out easel backing, which is helpful during display of photos so additional display holders are not needed.

Pictures submitted by our club members will be judged at the district level. Winners go on to state, and then national.

CFWC's Writing Contest is open to any member in good standing and to any youth enrolled in California grades K-12 or Home schooled.

Procedure:

Due by February 15th 2017 - Entries to be submitted by clubs (not required to be rejudged at the district level).

Requirements:

- * Entries must be written in the contest year.
- * Entries must be labeled in the top RH corner of each page with authors name, e-mail address, mailing address, phone number, name of author's GFWC Club and District (if a youth entry, the submitting GFWC club's name), designation of California Federation of Women's Clubs, category, and title of work. If a youth entry, indicate grade.
- * Entries must be typed, double spaced, printed on one side only, minimum margins of one0inch on all four sides, on 8.5 x 11 inch paper.
- * Entries must be accompanied by a signed Creative Art Waiver form (see following page) and available in the GFWC Club Manual.
- * Only one entry per category per individual
- * Authors must be amateurs not having earned more than \$500 annually from their writing.
- * Entries may not have been published prior to the competition and must be original works by the author.
- * Complete instructions and Creative Art Waiver form can be found in the GFWC Club Manual.

Categories for Members:

- * Fiction: short stories (limited to 2000 words)
- * Non-fiction: essays, memoirs (no word limit)
- * Poetry (minimum of 8 lines, maximum of 50 lines)

Categories for Youth:

- * Fiction: short stories (limited to 2000 words)
- * Non-fiction: essays (no word limit)
- * Poetry (minimum of 8 lines, maximum of 50 lines) Grouping by Grade: K-2, 3-5, 6-8, 9-12.

Entries will not be returned. Winning entries will be forwarded to GFWC. Further details are available at GFWC.org.
